You Don't Have To Be Afraid



“Fear not, for I am with you.” Isaiah 41:10

The cure for anxiety is knowing that God is with you! How can you fear when you know that He is near? Your heavenly Father is greater than all, and He loves you for who you are, not what you do.

God says, “fear not!” *Feeling* fear is not what determines whether you are in fear or not. Acting in fear is the determining factor. Courage is *feeling* scared to death, but saddling up anyway. We do not have to act in fear or talk fear, because God didn't tell us to do something we can't do! When we obey the Lord and do what we feel we cannot do, then His power helps us do what we could not do on our own. “Fear not” is obedience. Sometimes freedom is spelled R.E.P.E.N.T.

Fear Attracts The Negative



“The thing I greatly feared has come upon me.”

Job 3:25

Fear leaves the door open for things to come into your life that can destroy. To “not fear” is more than a good idea. It is safe! The devil is seeking an open door to devour people. One open door is “fear.” *“The devil is seeking whom he may devour.”* 1 Peter 5:8 *Feeling* fear does not mean you are *in* fear, but always talking your fears and acting on your fears does. Shut the door!

Just like faith opens the door to God being able to bless you, fear opens the door for the devil to harass you. Fear is a *choice* to think on the negative. Romans 8:6 says when our minds are on God and His loving Word, our lives will be in peace! Psalm 119:165
